

Background

First Lego League (FLL), is part of an educational initiative by the LEGO Group and non-profit organization <u>FIRST</u>. The program was created to **inspire young people to pursue careers in STEM.** The competition has three key categories: An innovation project, embodiment of core values and a robot game wherein the team completes specific missions in 2.5 minutes with robots they've created. For the next step towards Sydney, we have made some rough estimations of our expenses and have set out ambitions on how we want to raise these funds.

Art in Smart is the inaugural FLL team for Asker International School (AIS). Not only is it the first team from AIS to participate in FLL, it is the first time they have tried either as individuals in separate teams or individually.
